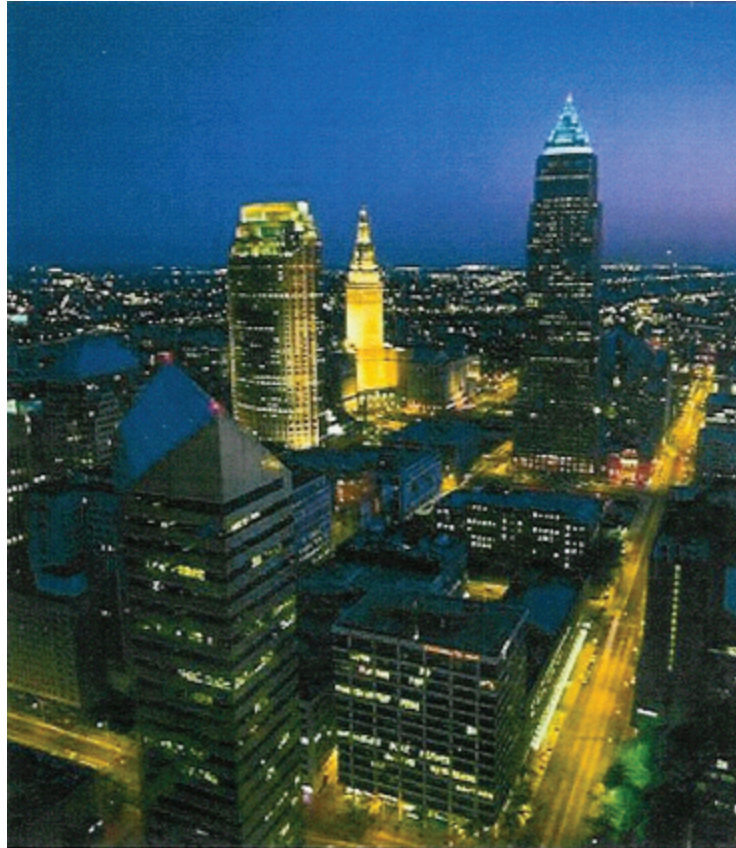

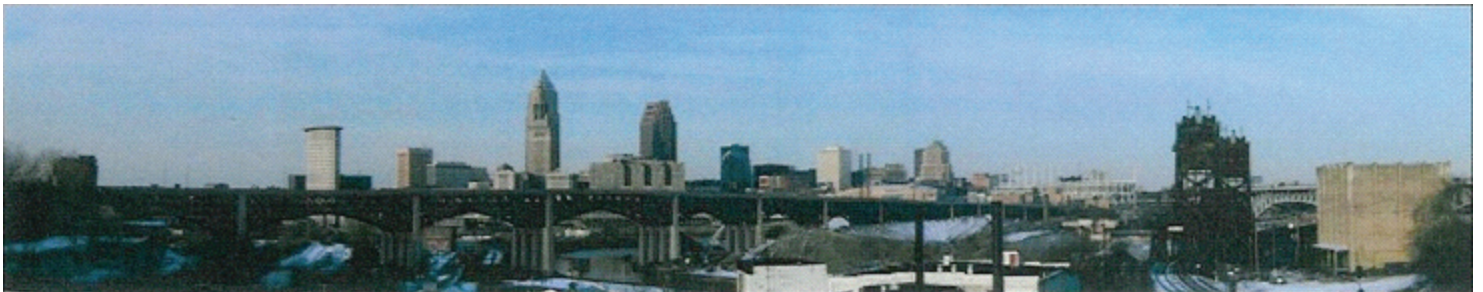

Rail Line: For a quick, convenient ride between Cleveland Hopkins International Airport and downtown Cleveland use the RTA Red Line. It's simple to catch and it's fast (just 22 minutes to ride to or from downtown Cleveland's Tower City Station) and inexpensive (only \$1.50 one way). RTA's Airport station is located on the lower level of the Terminal Complex. From Monday through Saturday the Red Line operates every 15 minutes from 4:30 a.m. until 12:59 a.m. On Sunday, the rapid operates until 9:55 p.m. Call RTA at 216/ 621-9500 for more information.
